- Preparation of all necessary manifest and bill of lading documentation associated with the management of wastes
- Understand and maintain applicable OSHA/DOT certifications along with Envirolaska's Health and Safety Policies
- Productively interact with coworkers and Envirolaska's customers in a team environment
